

Shadow days -

A student shadow day visit is an excellent opportunity for prospective students to experience, first hand, what the school has to offer. The goal of the shadow day is to simply allow students to experience a day at Immaculate Conception to get a better understanding of our programs and curriculum. Students will be partnered with an Immaculate Conception student with similar interests and “shadow” them through a typical school day. Students who are shadowing will follow a regular class schedule with students of their same grade level. We know that starting a school is a big decision for a student and their families. We encourage all interested students to come and see Immaculate Conception School, personally.

Shadow Day Visit Details:

- Typical shadow days are from 8:20 a.m. to 11:30 am, however students are welcome to stay and enjoy lunch in our cafeteria.
- Please report to the School Office at 8:15am.
- A Shadow Day visit is for students from Kindergarten – 8th grade. Parents are required to attend in the lower grades. It is intended to supplement an open house and/or a campus tour and allow the student to experience extended time in a real classroom on a typical school day.
- Shadow visitors may want to bring something to read in case the host has a quiz or test on the day of the visit. If interested, notebooks and writing instruments can be helpful.
- Students should be picked up in the School Office to be signed out. Students are responsible for their own transportation.
- Shadowing is not a mandatory part of the application process, but it is a great opportunity to learn more about Immaculate Conception School.

When scheduling a shadow day, you may request a current student host of your choice or allow us to match your child up with a host student based on their classroom and extra-curricular interests. We encourage shadow days on Thursdays so your child can attend mass. However, if Thursday is not a good fit, we can schedule a different day.

Please contact us at least 48 hours in advance of the anticipated visit so that we may notify the shadow host and allow them to prepare for the visit. There are no visits scheduled during final exams and the study week prior to final exams, or when the students are off-campus for field trips and service projects.
