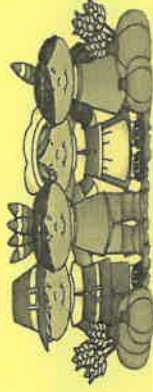

Character development through volunteerism in our community

Learning life skills through Scouting merit badge and rank activities

- A Scout progresses through age-appropriate activities to learn skills like First Aid, Cooking, and Outdoorsmanship to earn rank advancements.
- Scouts also complete Merit Badges. These are in-depth learning experiences focused on a specific topic like Citizenship, Communication, Personal Management, Cycling, Electronics, Camping, Lifesaving, Art, Photography, and many more.
- The program also promotes personal responsibility, leadership, and teamwork skills.

- We go camping four to five times per year.
- At our campouts and various activities, Scouts can participate in and earn Merit Badges for Climbing, Swimming, Archery, Rifle-shooting, Sailing, Fishing, Kayaking, and others!
